

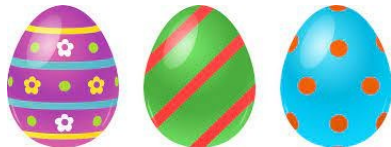


General Information Newsletter 2022-23
