Term Dates.

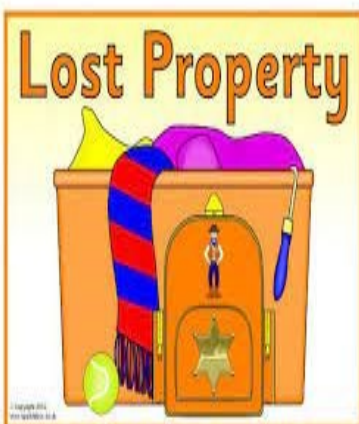
