

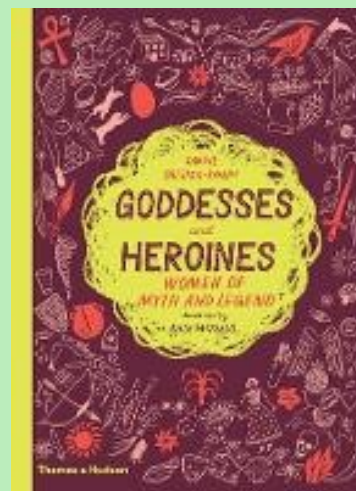


Seaford Primary school Reading Newsletter

Author visits

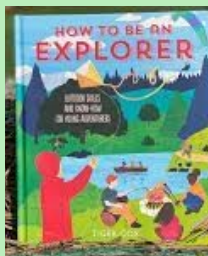

*Natalie Newman visited KS 1 and read from her book **Lark the Shark**. The children engaged in listening to the story and asking questions about writing books for children.*

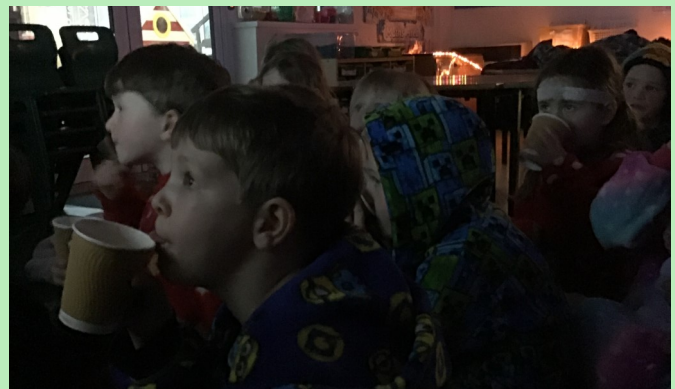
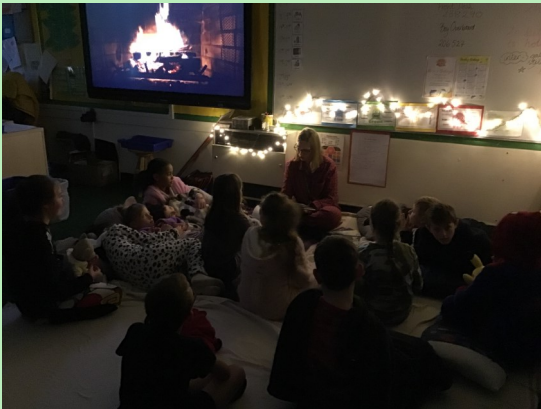
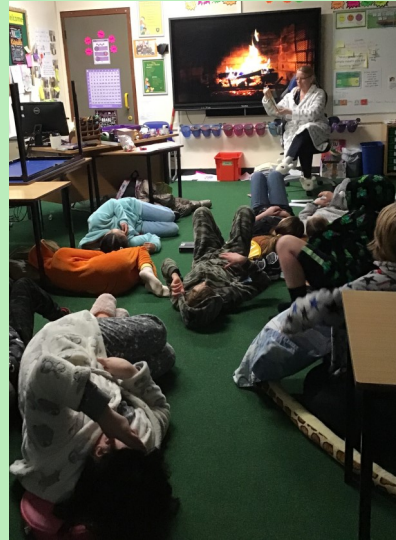

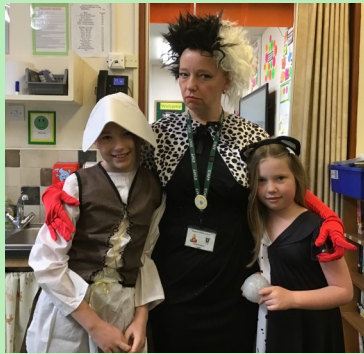


Books at Bedtime
